TASTING NOTES

2014 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

The very best fruit grown was used in the 2014 Warner Glen Estate Cabernet Sauvignon. Premium parcels of Margaret River Cabernet were carefully selected and given the full treatment in both the winery and the vineyard. Best French oak barriques were used with the wine being in barrel for 15 months, with the fruit off low yielding older vines giving wonderful intensity of flavour and great structure and palette weight.

Cellaring	Drink now to 2020
Colour	Deep purple red.
Bouquet	Deep brooding aromas that open into a lush rich palette with great intensity and persistence.
Palate	Black currant and medium toasted oak flavours and a rich soft mouthfeel from the silky ripe tannins make for a great wine.
Vintage	The 2014 vintage was outstanding for red varieties throughout Margaret River. Warmer than average, and dry conditions during the final phase of ripening, enabled viticulturists and winemakers to have a long window of opportunity for harvest. The 2014 Warner Glen Estate Cabernet Sauvignon vines benefitted from this long slow ripening to produce small, intensely flavoured berries with soft ripe tannins.
