

## 2014 SHIRAZ

The very best fruit grown was used in the 2014 Warner Glen Estate Shiraz. Premium parcels of southern Margaret River Shiraz were carefully selected and given the full treatment in both the winery and the vineyard. Best French oak barriques were used with the wine being in barrel for 15 months, with the fruit off low yielding older vines giving wonderful intensity of flavour and great structure and palette weight.

<b>Palate</b>	A dense, rich palette and chewy ripe tannins provide a sensory delight with each glass. The 2014 vintage was outstanding for red varieties throughout Margaret River. Warmer than average, and dry conditions during the final phase of ripening, enabled viticulturists and winemakers to have a long window of opportunity for harvest. The 2014 Warner Glen Estate Shiraz vines benefitted from this long slow ripening to produce small, intensely flavoured berries with soft ripe tannins.
